   5. Jake Frieden went over the Finance Committee report noting that we are still waiting on the fourth payment for transportation. The high school parking lot concrete work is nearing completion. PHYSICAL FITNESS
 DATA
 7. Mr. Petrie summarized the Physical Fitness Data reported by Illinois
 State Board of Education for the 2018-2019 school year. Three grade levels were tested (5<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, & 10<sup>th</sup>). Aerobic capacity, flexibility, muscular endurance, and muscular strength were measured. Overall, our students scored well, showing our physical fitness and athletic programs are doing well.

VOCATIONAL BUILDING 8. The Vocational Building at the High School experienced some roof REPAIRS damage on the east side, due to high winds. Our insurance carrier has approved the repair estimate from Riddell Roofing. We will be proceeding with repairs with a property deductible of \$1,000.

- FOOD SERVICE REPORT 9. Mr. Petrie summarized the Food Service Annual Report that was included in the board packet, comparing FY18 and FY19. The difference in revenue over the two years is due to a decreased number of students eligible for free or reduced lunches. There was also a noticeable difference in the number of high school students not eating the hot lunch.
- SUMMER 10. Mr. Petrie spoke on the progress of the Paving and Drainage projects taking place at the high school. Both projects are coming along nicely. The city replaced a gas line between the vocational building and the greenhouse. The parking lot on the east side of the vocational building has been graded helping with the drainage. The concrete pours have been completed with just a few things left to finish.
