CEP – Community Eligibility Provision

The district has met the 40% identified student percentage to participate in the Community Eligibility Provision for school year 2023-2024. Identified students include those who are direct certified free through SNAP, TANF, Homeless, and Foster. Students who qualify for free/reduced meals based on information from a household income form, are not included in that percentage to meet the criteria.

If approved by the BOE, this would allow all of our students that attend MCSD to receive meals for free for 4 consecutive years. This will be a discussion item on the April 26^{th} Regular BOE meeting.
