# HERBERT & ELIZABETH (BOGGUSS) MCMEEKIN SCHOLARSHIP

Elizabeth Bogguss was a former resident of Aledo and a high school graduate of Aledo High School. After moving away from Aledo she met and married Herbert McMeekin. Elizabeth passed away in December of 2014 and Herbert passed away in June of 2015. Upon their passing MCHS learned that the McMeekins had left a generous donation to Mercer County High School to be used as scholarship money for our students.

This scholarship will be awarded to at least 3 senior students every year. Two will be through an application process and one will be from a random drawing that takes place at an event such as College Night or something similar based solely on attendance and with the assurance that the student will be attending a higher level of education in the fall after their graduation.

**Random Drawing Scholarship:** Attend the event and enter to win. If your name is drawn you will be the winner of \$500.

**1 - \$2,000 scholarship**

**1- \$1,000 renewable scholarship for a maximum of four years**

To apply for the above two scholarships you must have a GPA of at least a 3.0. Scholarship recipients will be chosen by a Mercer County High School Scholarship Committee.

The recipient of the renewable scholarship must provide upcoming class schedule for sophomore, junior, and senior year of college in order to receive their scholarship money for the remaining three years. (This can be done in August at the beginning of the school year.)

**The application and essay need to be turned into the counselor's office by the end of the day on the fourth Friday of April.**
